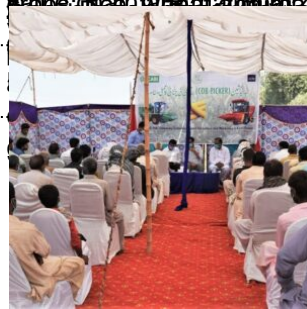

Punjab's agriculture growth rate has declined over the last [two decades](#) because of various challenges. These include the inadequate availability of high-yielding cultivars and lack of diversification in cultivation, inefficient farm water management, poor infrastructure for value chain development, weak research and extension services, and a lack of access to credit. The situation has been exacerbated by the impact of climate change, which has led to a decline in crop yields and a loss of biodiversity. The project aims to address these challenges by providing farmers with access to improved cultivars, training in water management and value chain development, and strengthening research and extension services. The project also aims to improve the sector's performance by providing farmers with access to credit and other services.
